You require 80 credits *minimum* to graduate. Included within these requirements, you **MUST** have:

- A *minimum* of 16 credits at the grade 12 level, so: 4 credits for English 12 **OR** Communications 12 **plus** 12 from Elective Choices;
- at least 4 credits of *either* a Fine Arts or Applied Skills course at any grade 10, 11, or 12 level;
- Graduation Transitions (GT) completed during your Grade 12 year; and
- A minimum of 52 credits of **Required courses** plus 28 credits of Elective courses.

The “Graduation Transitions” (GT) is a requirement for all BC Secondary school students enrolled in grade 12 and requirements commence when you enter grade 10. Successful completion of GT is mandatory for you to graduate, and to achieve your Diploma. GT is intended to facilitate you in your transition to life after secondary school. Upon successful completion of GT, you receive 4 credits.

In order to receive credit for GT, you must provide evidence of your achievements in 3 required areas:

1. Personal Health (100 hours of physical activity in grades 10, 11 **and** 12);
2. Community Connections (30 hours of paid or voluntary work experience): and
3. a Career and Life Transition Plan (demonstrated in your Portfolio in *myblueprint*).

All areas of GT are documented in *myblueprint*, and will require you to showcase your Portfolio in an “exit interview”.
