To graduate, a student must earn a minimum of 80 grade 10, 11 and/or 12 credits. Each full-semester course is worth 4 credits. In grade 10 a student is required to take the English 10, a Math 10 (FMP or AWM) and the Science 10 provincial exams. In grade 11, the Socials 11 or First Nations Studies 12 exam is required and in grade 12, either the English or Communications 12 provincial is required. Students must have at least 4 credits of either a Fine Art or Applied Skills course and a minimum of 12 elective credits (3 full semester courses) at the grade 12 level. Grad Transitions is mandatory and must be completed before the end of grade 12. At GW Graham, grade 12 students are automatically signed up for this course and it is done outside the timetable. Please refer to the Grad Planner on the opposite side of this sheet for planning purposes. See Ms. Schramm in C167 if you have questions.
