## 2018 GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

You require 80 credits *minimum* to graduate. Included within these requirements, you **MUST** have:

- A *minimum* of 16 credits at the grade 12 level: specifically 4 credits for English 12 **plus** 12 from Elective Choices;
- at least 4 credits of **either** a Fine Arts or Applied Skills course at any grade 10, 11, or 12 level;
- Career Life Connections (CLC) & Capstone Project completed during your Grade 12 year; and
- A minimum of 52 credits of **Required courses** plus 28 credits of Elective courses
- **Grade 11** must do the Numeracy Assessment in January or June of grade 11 year & Literacy Assessment after EN12 in Grade 12.

The “Career Life Connections” (CLC) is a requirement for all BC Secondary school students enrolled in grade 12 and requirements commence when you enter grade 9. Successful completion of CLC is mandatory for you to graduate, and to achieve your Diploma. CLC is intended to facilitate you in your transition to life after secondary school as outlined in your Capstone Project in your grade 12 interview. Upon successful completion of CLC, you receive 4 credits. For further information, please contact your Counselor (see below - by Alpha by last name).
